

Wheel Stud Replacement

Removal Procedure


- 1. Raise and suitably support the vehicle. Refer to <u>Lifting and Jacking the Vehicle</u>.
- Remove the tyre and wheel assembly. Refer to Tyre and Wheel Removal and Installation.
 Remove the wheel bearing/hub. Refer to Rear Wheel Bearing and Hub Replacement.



4. Release the wheel stud (1) from the bearing hub with the hydraulic press and DISCARD the stud.

Installation Procedure

- 1. Install a NEW stud into the bearing/hub assembly (2). Add enough washers (3) in order to draw the stud into the hub.
- 2. Install and tighten a wheel nut (1) until the head of the wheel stud is fully seated against the back of the bearing/hub flange (2).
- 3. Remove the wheel nut (1) and the washers (3).
- Install the wheel bearing/hub (2). Refer to Rear Wheel Bearing and Hub Replacement.
 Install the tyre and wheel assembly. Refer to Tyre and Wheel Removal and Installation.
- 6. Lower the vehicle.
